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#### **SPEECH TREK SPEECH CONTEST TOPIC**

### IS IT TIME TO PASS THE EQUAL RIGHTS AMENDMENT?

The **Equal Rights Amendment (ERA)** was a proposed amendment to the United States Constitution designed to guarantee equal rights for women. The ERA was originally written by Alice Paul and Crystal Eastman. In 1923, it was introduced in the Congress for the first time.

Several attempts to ratify the amendment were made in 1972, 1978 and then a possible ratification in 1982, but it still has never been put into law.

Actress Patricia Arquette, who made headlines and brought new attention to the gender pay gap with her infamous 2015 Oscar speech has started a petition to assure the passage of ERA NOW!

"People think it's a women-only issue but it's not," Arquette told PEOPLE magazine. "It's an equality issue.

Filmmaker Kamala Lopez's new film, Equal Means Equal, examines the startling effects of gender inequality in the United States, the inadequacy of current laws in place and the dedicated advocates who've been fighting for decades to rectify the situation.

Is it time to pass the Equal Rights Amendment? If so, how can this be accomplished? How can organizations such as AAUW help in getting this amendment ratified once and for all?

#### **CONTEST INFORMATION**

**Eligibility**: Speech Trek is open to all actively attending high school students in California.

**Deadlines**: Interested students must submit an "Student Application and Parent/Guardian Permission" notice to their local AAUW CA Branch.

**Time Limits:** Students are to prepare an original 5-6-minute speech, with a "30 grace period on either side. Speaking under the 4:30 or over 6:30 will result in disqualification.

**Presentation:** These presentations are to be original speeches. Appropriate use of one 4" x 6" note card is an option--prompting is not allowed.

**Judging:** During the State Semi-Final and Final competition, judges shall use the official ballot and score each speaker in each of the four areas: Content, 0-40 points; Organization, 0-10 points; and Delivery, 0-50 points. Branches may opt to use their own judge's ballot at the local level. Students are advised to request a copy of their Branch's judge's ballot.

**Prizes**: Each local Branch of AAUW CA will determine the level of award for their contestants.

**Branch Winner:** Each participating branch will post the video of their winning speech online by March 1. The State Speech Trek judges will identify five finalists, two of which will be named as Honorable Mention. The judges will award the 4<sup>th</sup> place finalist with \$250 and the 5<sup>th</sup> place finalist with \$150. The State Speech Trek judges will invite the top three finalist to compete for cash prizes at the AAUW CA State Convention/Annual Meeting in April.

**State Finalists:** First place winner at the State contest will receive \$1500; Second place winner at the State contest will receive \$1000 and Third place winner at the State contest will receive \$500. Travel expenses, lodging, and meals for each finalist and her/his chaperone will be reimbursed by Speech Trek. Those expenses should not exceed approved budget.
