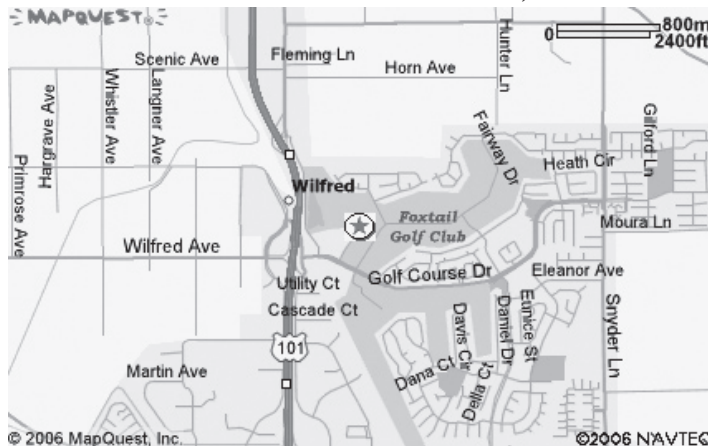

Airport to Hotel Transportation is provided by Sonoma County Airport Express. The fare from Oakland and San Francisco Airports is \$28 one way for adults and \$26 one way for Seniors (62+). Tickets can be purchased in advance on-line or directly from the driver. Schedules are available on the website. Be advised that the travel time from the Bay Area Airports to the hotel is 2 hours.

Transportation from the Sonoma County Airport in Santa Rosa can be purchased from the Sonoma County Airport Express for \$10 cash to the driver. This schedule is also available on the transportation website. However, return transportation from the hotel to the Sonoma County Airport can only be obtained through a cab company. The estimated cost of a cab with up to five passengers is about \$40.

Driving Directions from Oakland Airport

1. Start at 1 AIRPORT DR, OAKLAND going toward JOHN GLENN DR - go 0.3 mi
2. Turn Right on ALAN SHEPARD WAY toward PASSENGER TERMINAL
3. Turn Right on JOHN GLENN DR - go 0.3 mi
4. Turn Left on AIRPORT DR - go 0.9 mi
5. Continue on AIRPORT ACCESS RD - go 0.3 mi
6. Bear Right on HEGENBERGER RD - go 0.8 mi
7. Take ramp onto I-880 N toward DOWNTOWN OAKLAND - go 6.4 mi



8. Take Right fork onto I-980 E toward WALNUT CREEK (CA-24) - go 1.5 mi
9. Take the SAN FRANCISCO/HAYWARD exit onto I-580 W toward SAN FRANCISCO - go 2.0 mi
10. Merge onto I-580 W (Portions toll) - go 17.1 mi
11. Exit onto US-101 N - go 32.3 mi
12. Take the GOLF COURSE DR/WILFRED AVE exit - go 0.2 mi
13. Turn Left on COMMERCE BLVD
14. Turn Right on GOLF COURSE DR - go 0.2 mi

From San Francisco Airport

1. Start at 1 BUSH ST, SAN FRANCISCO going toward BATTERY ST
2. Bear Right on BATTERY ST
3. Continue on 1ST ST - go 0.5 mi
4. Take ramp onto I-80 E toward BAY BRIDGE/OAKLAND - go 6.7 mi
5. Merge onto I-580 W (Portions toll) - go 17.1 mi
6. Exit onto US-101 N - go 32.3 mi
7. Take the GOLF COURSE DR/WILFRED AVE exit - go 0.2 mi
8. Turn Left on COMMERCE BLVD
9. Turn Right on GOLF COURSE DR - go 0.2 mi
10. Turn Left on DOUBLETREE DR - go 0.1 mi
11. Arrive at DOUBLETREE DR, ROHNERT PARK

From Santa Rosa Airport

1. Start at 2200 AIRPORT BLVD, SANTA ROSA - go 1.6 mi
2. Take ramp onto US-101 S - go 11.3 mi
3. Take the WILFRED AVE/GOLF COURSE DR exit - go 0.3 mi
4. Turn Right on REDWOOD DR - go 0.2 mi
5. Turn Right on COMMERCE BLVD - go 0.2 mi
6. Turn Left on GOLF COURSE DR - go 0.2 mi
7. Turn Left on DOUBLETREE DR - go 0.1 mi
8. Arrive at DOUBLETREE DR, ROHNERT PARK
