

## **JUNIOR / SENIOR COUNSELOR JOB DESCRIPTION**

As a Junior or Senior Counselor, you will not be a camper anymore and you will have a greater degree of freedom. With this acceptance comes responsibility. You will be expected to exercise good judgment and remember that safety is of great concern. Your behavior must be exemplary. You will be a role model to younger campers who will be observing your every action. You will have the opportunity to help campers find their way around campus and help them through homesickness. If you are friendly and are having a good time, younger girls will catch your positive spirit. Your positive attitude and outlook may be of more help to the girls than any other thing you do. Since this is an exhausting week, you will be expected to abide by the dorm closure and bedtime hours, sleep in your own bed, and attend all meals and activities.

You will have free time. Times for you as an individual and for your group will be set up. As always, we will have some challenges, but you will be given time just to have some fun. We want you to enjoy your second experience at Tech Trek.

Camp dress is casual. There are a few restrictions: spaghetti strap tops and bare midriffs will not be allowed; no flip flops will be allowed outside of the dorm due to safety and medical concerns, short shorts are not acceptable. Remember you are a role model for the campers—your appearance is important.

### **YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES MAY INVOLVE:**

1. Assisting in preparation of buildings and campus areas for Sunday registration.
2. Assisting Dorm Moms in the building where you are assigned.
3. Be there to meet and greet campers and their families on Sunday arrival.
4. Attend dorm meetings in your buildings.
5. Meet with your supervisor each morning to be informed of the day's activities, new assignments, and changes in schedules.
6. Assisting the teacher to whose morning class you will be assigned.
7. Assisting in daily afternoon activities as assigned.
8. Assisting in setting up snacks.
9. Assisting on campus field trips.
10. Other tasks as assigned by Director(s).

Camp staff will arrive on Saturday. Camper arrival and registration will be on Sunday. After registration and distribution of keys and t-shirts, campers will move into rooms with your assistance. This is a great opportunity to make the girls feel welcome and at ease
