Six Steps to ensure your success # 1 Step 1. Study or Survey your Community: Successful, well-attended programs address issues that are of interest to the community.

Six Steps to ensure your Success # 2 Step 2. Choose Meaningful Programs Choose programs that are salient to the audience. Is the program mission based? Will the program engage both current and new members?

Six Steps to ensure your Success # 3 Choose your program format. Decide which format will work better, a single presenter or a panel of speakers. If it is a panel choose individuals with diverse backgrounds.

Six Steps to ensure your Success # 4 Collaborate with diverse groups such as College/university partners or Banks/Financial institutions. It increases AAUW's presence in community.

Six Steps to ensure Your Success # 5

Plan logistics for the program. Choose a time and location that is convenient for the audience you want to attract. Food is always a big draw. Keep in mind parking access.

Six Steps to ensure Your Success # 6 Spread the word in the community with posters and flyers, newspaper announcements, and e-mails. Work with other community groups and social media.
