2021 Virtual Camp - Recap

- ★ 624 campers over three weeks of camp
- ★ 229 volunteers
- \star >10,000 hours in prep time
- ★ Single Core Class -- Qualcomm's Thinkabit Wearable Tech attended by all students
- ★ Twelve 90-min workshops offered: 4 mandatory, 8 optional
 - 4% of campers (~25) achieved "SuperSTEMinist" status by attending ALL offerings
- ★ Daily Inspiration Hour when professionals from STEM fields shared with campers



2022 Tech Trek Camp Plans

- ★ New Tech Trek Program Director and Financial Liaison selected
- ★New Tech Trek Committee selected
- ★ Tech Trek Camp Directors met Oct 10 to plan for 2022 camps
 - Current plans are for IN-PERSON camps in 2022
 - o Total of 9 weeks of camp on 7 CU partner campuses
 - Looking for a LiveScan/Background Check coordinator and co or assistant director and/or director in training for Stanford-Curie
- ★ Researching software platforms to switch to electronic forms

Five Work Groups tackled Tech Trek issues/concerns:

★ Administration: Reform program administration, create Branch Coordinator peer group, provide appropriate training for all volunteer roles, diversify staffing to match local demographics, adjust allocation of camp slots

- ★ Curriculum: Establish relationships with professional STEM organizations, Camp Director resource guide
- ★ Evaluation/Marketing: Print media updates, Camp Director training & best practices for camp/staff evaluation, statewide social media presence, comprehensive evaluation strategy, better tracking of campers, websites updates

Finance: Review job descriptions, revamp stipends, clarify family fee
