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	AB 1844	Requires affirmation from applicant for College position that they have not previously incurred adverse findings of sexual harassment	D
	*AB 1968	Requires campuses to develop and post uniform guidelines for reporting sexual assaults	C
	AB 2482	Requires 5 pilot program college campuses to provide at least one “wellness” vending machine	C
	AB 2525	Adds “gender expression” and “gender identity” to hate crime violence for purposes of actions by State Board of Education	D
	AB 2806	Would require DoE to track and report date on suspension and expulsion of children in state-run pre-schools	C
	AB 2832	Requires DSS to develop screening tool designed to counter racial and economic inequity in childcare	C
	*AB 2881	Provides additional support for college students with dependent children	C
	SB 70	Would require all 1 <sup>st</sup> graders to have completed 1 year of kindergarten	V
