



CIVIL CONTROL ADMINISTRATION AND AND FOURTH ARMY Presidio of San Francisco, California April 1, 1942 INSTRUCTIONS TO ALL PERSONS OF JAPANESE ANCESTRY Living in the Following Area:

All that portion of the City and County of San Francisco, State of California, lying generally west of the north-south line established by Junipero Serra Boulevard, Worchester Avenue, and Nineteenth Avenue, and lying generally north of the east-west line established by California Street, to the intersection of Market Street, and thence on Market Street

All Japanese persons, both alien and non-alien, will be evacuated from the above designated area by 12:00 o'clock noon Tuesday, April 7, 1942.

No Japanese person will be permitted to enter or leave the above described area after 8:00 a.m., Thursday, April 2, 1942, without obtaining special permission from the Provost Marshal at the Civil Control Station located at:

1701 Van Ness Avenue

San Francisco, California

The Civil Control Station is equipped to assist the Japanese population affected by this evacuation in the following ways:

Give advice and instructions on the evacuation.

2. Provide services with respect to the management, leasing, sale, storage or other disposition of most kinds of property including: real estate, business and professional equipment, buildings, household goods, boats, automobiles,

3. Provide temporary residence elsewhere for all Japanese in family groups.

4. Transport persons and a limited amount of clothing and equipment to their new residence, as specified below.



From Westminster to a Federal Class Action Lawsuit!

- The Palomino, Ramirez, Estrada, and Guzman Families join the effort.
- Marcus' Key Case Decisions:
 - Filed in US District Federal Court not California State Court
 - Citizens unequally treated White vs. Mexican American students • Violates the Equal Protection Clause in 14th Ammendment.

• Mendez hires Attorney David Marcus with profits from the asparagus crop.

• March 2, 1945: Marcus filed case at US District Court, Los Angeles. • July 5-11, 1945: Trial with Judge Paul McCormick.

February 18, 1946: Judge McCormick ruled in favor of the families!

Sylvia, Gonzalo, and Jerome go to Seventeenth Street School in Westminster! BUT...Ruling appealed by the other 3 School Districts.




- December 1946: Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals trial.
- April 14, 1947: Upholds Judge Paul McCormick's ruling for the Families!
- June 1947: Anderson Bill introduced/passed by State Assembly & State Senate.
- Calif. Gov. Earl Warren -> US Supreme Court Chief Justice and rules on Brown v. Board of Education 1954 at a National level.











Poston "Camp" 1942-1945 Population: 17, 814




