Kode With Klossy

Every summer, Kode With Klossy provides free, immersive coding camps with curricula covering web development, artificial intelligence, mobile app development, or data science. KWK offers both virtual and in-person coding camps across the nation for girls aged 13-18.

Girls Who Code offers various summer programs in web development, data science, and computer science fundamentals for high schoolers grades 9-11. Both summer camps are available through either their 2-week virtual Summer Immersion Program, or the 6-week asynchronous Self Paced Program. Priority applications are due February 14, 2024 & regular admissions are due March 22, 2024.

AEOP Apprenticeships

The Army Educational Outreach Program offers paid internships for high school and undergraduate students in local universities or laboratories across the United States. The application is currently open & deadlines vary by location and are updated on a rolling basis.

Salk Institute Heithoff-Brody High School Scholars Program

The Salk Institute's annual internship program for high schoolers is now accepting applications until April 5th, 2024. Applicants must be a resident of San Diego County and at least 16 years of age on or before June 17th, 2024. This intensive internship provides an immerse paid laboratory experience for 30-40 hours per week throughout the summer, with a concluding final research project with Salk Institute scientists and mentors.
