## Team Member Responsibilities

Thank you for participating in Lobby Days! Below is an overview of team member roles and responsibilities.

### Core Team Members

- Have an active speaking role in the meeting.
- Speak about branch activities in the community.
- Present one or more priority bills.
- Be mindful of time so priority bills can be fully covered.
- For large teams (more than 5–6 core members), speakers may rotate between the two meetings so that more members have an opportunity to speak. The Team Leader will coordinate this.

### Optional Team Members

- Do not typically have a speaking role.
- Attend to meet the legislator, show AAUW's strength in the district, and support the core team.
- May speak only if the core team is small and additional speakers are needed.

### Dual Members

- Some people are core members on two teams (one in-district and one Zoom). This is to ensure that every participant has the opportunity to meet with both of their legislators.
- If you prefer to serve on only one team, notify the Team Leader of the team you wish to leave.
