

## **AAUW California Tech Trek COVID Policy**

- 1. AAUW California Tech Trek will be in compliance with all federal, state, local, and campus-specific COVID guidance and regulations for in-person events.
- 2. All in-person attendees must either be up to date with a COVID vaccine that is approved and recommended by the CDC (including any booster doses when eligible) or a doctor-authorized medical exemption similar to this one <u>supported</u> by any UC system <u>university</u> where a camp is taking place.
- 3. Evidence of immunization or medical exemption/waiver must be submitted via online system on request, no later than two weeks prior to camp start date.
- 4. Parents will also be required to complete a student waiver releasing AAUW from all liability associated with COVID, no later than two weeks prior to camp start date.
- All camp participants including campers and camp staff will be tested when they check in on arrival at camp. If they test positive for COVID, they will not be allowed to stay.
  - a. It is highly recommended that campers and staff be tested at home within 24 hours prior to arrival at camp to avoid unnecessary travel and confusion.
  - Untested participants may not be allowed on campuses. Home test results will not be accepted as proof of negative test and are for family information only.
- 6. Masking will be required indoors by all attendees and staff except during meals or when properly socially distanced.
- 7. Social distancing will comply with current campus, city, county and state requirements.
- 8. Daily wellness checks will be conducted and documented for all attendees.
- 9. If symptoms develop at any time among campers or staff, rapid antigen testing will be done. If the camper or minor staff member tests positive, parents will be contacted for pick up as soon as possible. The affected individual will be isolated from the rest of the camp while waiting for parents to arrive. Adult staff members who test positive will be required to leave camp.
