1. How much are dues for CU Membership?

Dues are \$250 per year.

(There may be dues for membership at the State and local Branch level, if desired.)

Student Membership Dues (Non-College/University Member School): \$18.81/annual

6. What benefits are available to staff and faculty at a CU member campus? Do they get free membership?

Each AAUW College/University (CU) Member Campus is awarded two complimentary AAUW Individual National Memberships. Please note that state and branch dues are separate and may differ depending on location. The recipients of these memberships serve as CU Representatives for your institution. Additional staff and faculty who wish to join AAUW may do so at the standard

national rate of \$76, with separate fees applicable for local branch and state membership.

All staff and faculty at CU member campuses have access to the Virtual Trainings made available by AAUW National, including Salary Negotiation (Work Smart), Financial Literacy (Money Smart), and Voter Education programs.

7. Why should a college or university sign up to be an AAUW CU member?

By joining AAUW, your college or university joins a **network of over 450 institutions** committed to our vision of *equity for all*. AAUW's membership also includes over 50,000 individuals and 700+ branches across the country.
